





Consonant Hn

Ask children to name the letters by the newt at the top of the page. Have them find and circle Wn's on the page. Then have them trace and write N and n in the space provided.


















Relate Nn to /n/




Consonant Ss

Ask children to name the letters at the top of the page. Have them find and circle Ss's on the page. Then have them trace and write the S and s in the space provided.






















Relate 5s to /s/




























Relate Rr to Irl
