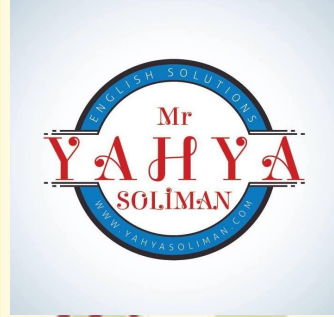


# Where Is My Hat?
