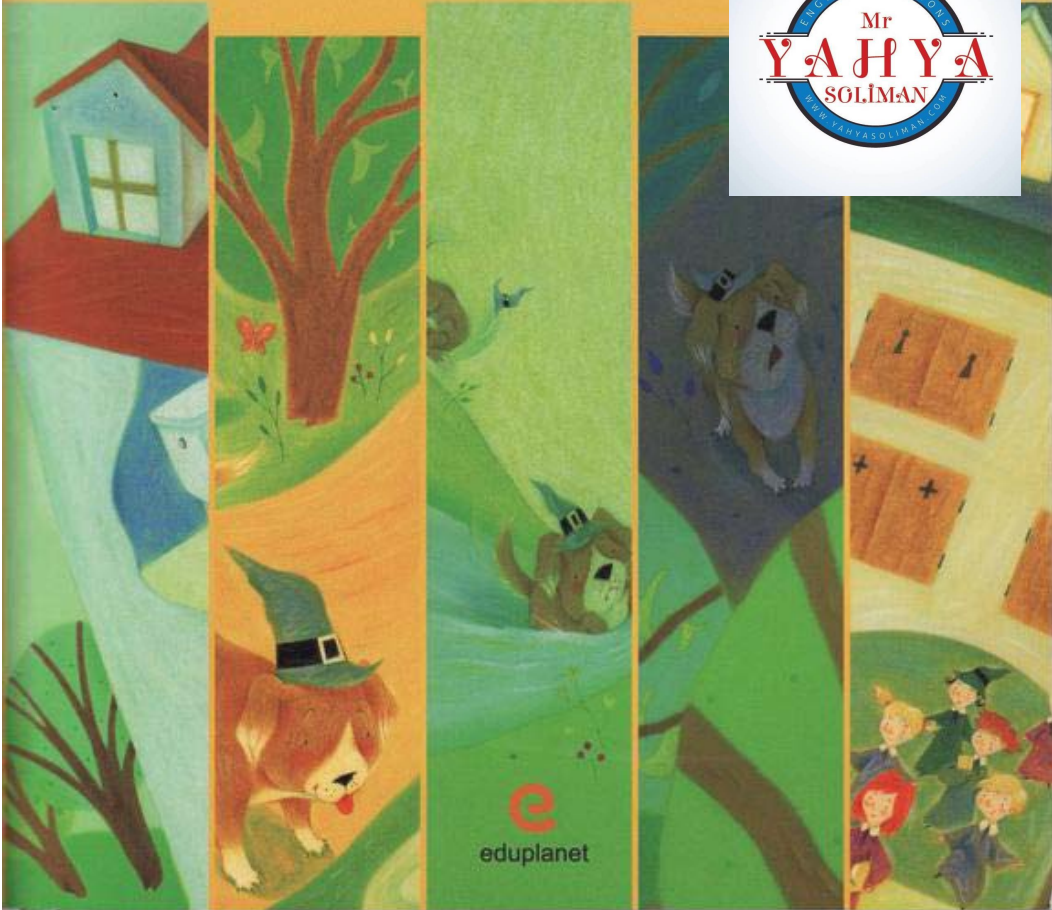

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Introduction

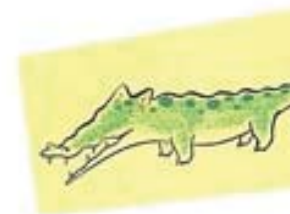

How to Use This Book

Sentence Master lets students practice the usage of words in sentences.

Comprehension Master checks students' understanding of the story.

Let's Read More is a short non-fiction story and comprehension questions designed to extend students' knowledge.

Let's Practice gives students an opportunity to practice patterns they find in the story.

Let's Check checks students' understanding of the story by asking them to fill in the missing blanks in the summary.

Let's Study is where students can practice academic comprehension skills.

Audio CD features two speeds. One is normal. The other is slow. Students can listen to slow speed first and then practice listening at the normal speed.



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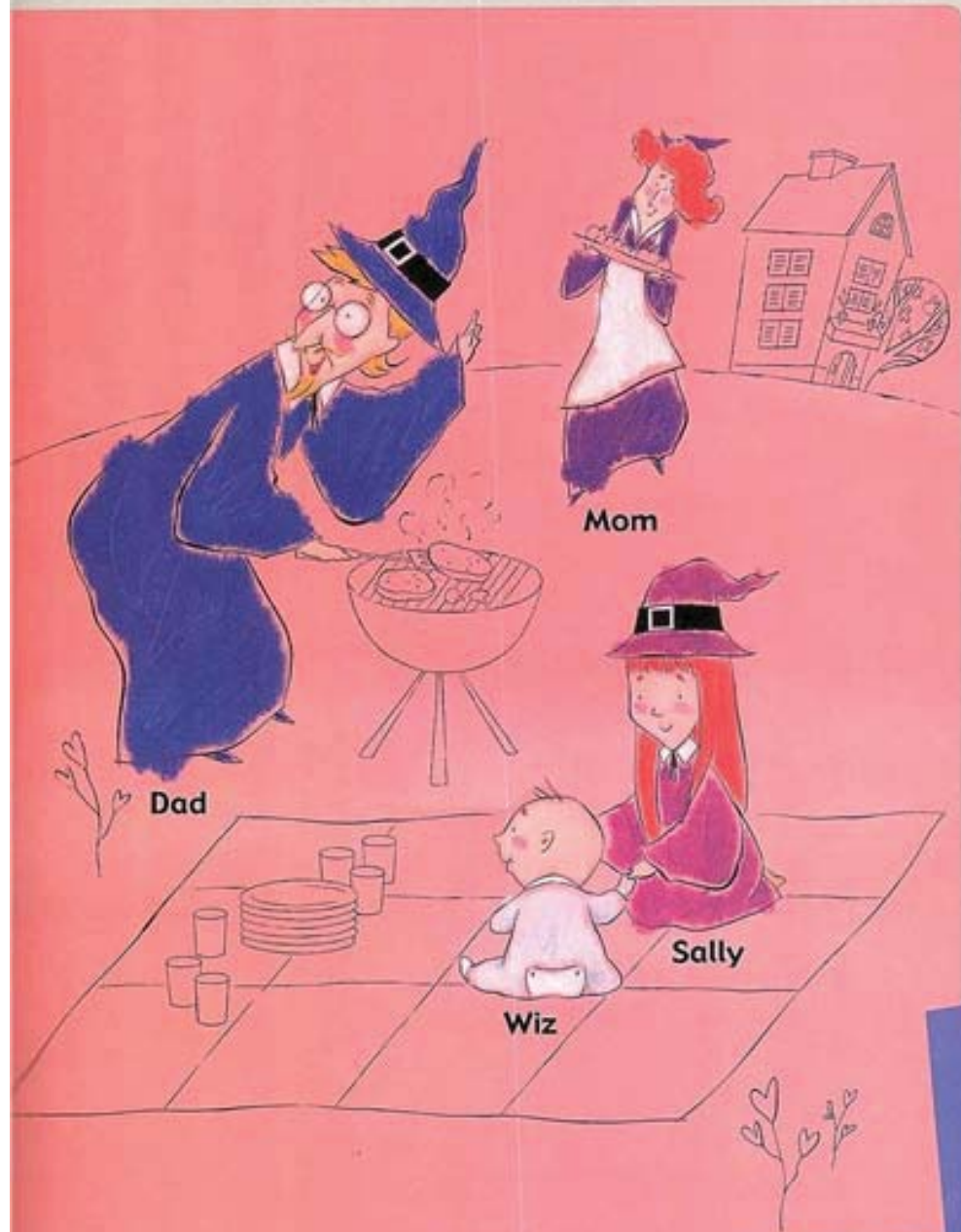
